

An innovative solution elaborated in the partnership, under the new EQAVET recommendations, that consist in:

- ◆ eQvet-us reference framework - establishes a series of 61 indicators addressed at VET Providers that have already QMS incorporated in their organizations and wishes to continually improve the effectiveness of the quality management system, through the establishment of quality indicators to monitor and promote their sustainable development. It is settled based on the 3 pillars of sustainable development: social, economic and environmental, embedded in the 7 social responsibility core subjects referenced in ISO26000, adapted to training delivery context: organizational governance, human rights, labor practices, environment, fair operating practices, consumer issues, community involvement and development.

- ◆ eQvet-us practice set - a guide for implementing, evaluation, review and a self-diagnostic tool that serves to implement and to use the eQvet-us framework for the improvement of the organization in the sense of the new eco skills and environmental sustainable economy. It consists of 3 parts: framework for sustainable development, self diagnostic tool, implementation guide.

- ◆ eQvet-us recommendation guide, that contains activities related to maintenance of the quality assurance systems implemented by VET providers: good practices, strategies to support future implementation. It is a result of the implementation and test of eQvet-us framework and practice set in partner organizations and multiplier events organized in the 6 partner countries.

What happened in the meantime?

In February 2015 a common mediation session was held in Vienna, Austria where the eQvet-us framework was started to be developed. It was discussed between partners in June 2016 in Sofia Bulgaria. The final form of the eQvet-us framework and practice set was established in November 2016 during the partner meeting in Berlin, Germany.

In the interval November 2015 – January 2016 partners have implemented the eQvet-us framework in their own organizations in a self-assessment process by means of eQvet-us practice set.

In February 2016 multiplier events were organized in the 6 partner countries.
