

An innovative four levels extensive evaluation model for scalable Eco skills and sustainable training evaluation of trainees participating in VET programs is elaborated in the partnership.

It provides the structure for eco skills in vocational education according to the definitions and explanations about the environmental pillar, formulated in the eQvet-us framework, but also the eco skills scale, an instrument used to measure the trainee ability to demonstrate a competency on the job.

The eQvet-us training evaluation is a green methodology which allows the peer learning process for trainees that is created by employment of mobile technology and regulates assessment of the course material. Google forms a free software solution can be employed for assessment.

◆ The new **eQvet-us Methodology for scalable Eco skills and sustainable training evaluation**, provides evaluation on four levels: Reaction evaluation; Learning evaluation; Behavior evaluation; Result evaluation: investigate the effects on the business or environment resulting from the trainee's performance.

Synthesis methodologies for reaction, learning, behaviour and result evaluations are presented as well as corresponding questionnaires.

◆ **eQvet-us recommendation guide**, contains activities related to implementation of eQvet-us methodology by VET providers: good practices, strategies to support future implementation. It is a result of the implementation and test of eQvet-us methodology in partner organizations and multiplier events organized in the 6 partner countries.

### What happened in the meantime?

In November 2015 at the partner meeting in Berlin, Germany the first ideas for development of an eQvet-us evaluation model of training assessment were discussed. The final form of the eQvet-us **Methodology for scalable Eco skills and sustainable training evaluation** was established in April 2016 during the partner meeting in Vienna, Austria.

In the interval April – August 2016 partners have implemented the eQvet-us methodology in their own organizations. In the same period multiplier events were organized in the 6 partner countries.
