

In the national final conference in Romania participated representatives from each partner institutions also outside Romania: ISQ Portugal, BEST Austria, EVBB Germany, ECQ Bulgaria, IDEP France.

It was a one day final valorisation event with presentations of project outputs, demonstrations with eQvet-us products, which gathered national VET players, policy makers and stakeholders, over 100 participants from Romania and 10 participants from abroad.

It was presented the project products:

- ◆ eQvet-us framework and practice set,
- ◆ eQvet-us methodology for scalable Eco skills and sustainable training evaluation.

Results from implementation and testing of eQvet-us outcomes in partner countries were presented.

Discussions and debates with target group participants were organised in order to get their impressions and suggestions for project sustainability activities:

- ◆ *Florin Rotaru, Auditor, CERTIND Certification Body*: The EQVET-US framework for sustainable development has a large potential to be employed in practice, in the VET area where is a gap in sustainability models and support of training providers.
- ◆ *Ioan Macarie, Inspector, Mures County School Inspectorate* – The first to levels of the Eqvet-us Methodology for training evaluation has a large potential to facilitate classroom processes such as: participation, collaboration, cognitive involvement while the other two levels are a confirmation of a proper design of the course content.

Before and after the event a lot of regional press releases, radio and TV interviews were awarded.

With this, the eQvet-us project ends but its innovative products remain available in 6 languages for a long period of time
